Ordinance No. 86

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE CODIFICATION OF THE CITY OF SENECA'S GENERAL ORDINANCES ORGANIZED BY SUBJECT MATTER KNOWN AS THE SENECA CITY CODE

The City Council for the City of Seneca make the following findings:

1. The City of Seneca has provided for the organization of the general ordinances of the City that have on going effect into a Code organized by subject matter; and
2. The Code should be adopted as the body of law of the City of Seneca; the Seneca City Code.

The City of Seneca Ordains as Follows:

Section 1. Adoption, Amendment and Repeal.

- 1.1 There is hereby adopted the SENECA CITY CODE which consists of ordinances of the City that have ongoing effect and which have not expired according to their own terms.
- 1.2 This Code may be cited as the Seneca City Code.
- 1.3 This Code may be amended by reference to Code section without the necessity of referring to the underlying ordinance.
- 1.4 New ordinances may be added to the Code, and if an ordinance is enacted with a numbering system that is inconsistent with the Code numbering system, the City Manager, Recorder or Clerk is authorized to assign an appropriate Code number and to codify the ordinance accordingly.
- 1.5 The repeal of any Code section does not revive the original text of the Code section, but rather, repeal of an existing section repeals the underlying ordinance section and all of its amendments.

Section 2. Codification of the Code does not affect violations, rights and obligations. The adoption of this Code shall not affect any civil or criminal prosecution for violations of ordinances, which violations were committed prior to the effective date of the adoption of the Seneca City Code, nor shall the adoption of the Seneca City Code be construed as a waiver of any license, fee, or penalty due and owing at the effective date of the Code adoption, nor shall adoption affect the validity of any bond or cash deposited with the City pursuant to the terms of

any ordinance, upon its codification; but rather, all rights and obligations pertaining under ordinances in effect prior to codification shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 3. Severability. If any section, subsection, clause or phrase of this Code is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Code. The City declares that it would have enacted this Code, and each section, subsection, sentence, clause and phrase thereof irrespective of the fact that one or more sections, subsections, sentences, clauses or phrases had been declared invalid or unconstitutional.

Section 4. Effective date. This Code shall become effective on the date the ordinance adopting this Code as the Seneca City Code shall become effective.

ADOPTED by the City Council of the City of Seneca at a regular meeting thereof this 10 day of July, 2007 and filed with the City of Seneca this same day.
