Meter Reading Time Again!

You may have seen Josh, Jerry Wayne, and Shane out on May 1st, this was to get a base line for each service customer in Seneca. Your normal fees cover 10,000 gallons of usage per month. If you go over, you will have a bigger bill, so watch your usage and check those pipes and leaky faucets!

Dog Nuisance Notifications

Per direction of the City Council, the Office of the City Manager is pursuing the legality of dealing with nuisance animals within city limits. The City is also looking into having an Animal Control Officer that would deal with the owners of/and the nuisance animals. The City Code describes a nuisance animal as one that chases vehicles, causes damage, leaves droppings/debris, chases/bites people, injures or kills other animals/livestock, scatters garbage, trespasses, is running at large, excessively barks/makes noises, is a "dangerous animal" as defined by Oregon State Law, and/or is not on a leash of less than 10' when not on real property of the owner.
