A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE USE OF STATE HIGHWAY FUNDS ADMINISTERED BY THE OREGON TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION FOR THE PAVING AND IMPROVEMENT OF SHIRTTAIL CREEK ROAD

WHEREAS, the Oregon Transportation Commission has allocated state highway funds for use in the repair, reconstruction, and improvement of city streets that are not part of the state highway system, with a focus on enhancing transportation infrastructure at the local level; and

WHEREAS, the City of Seneca has identified Shirttail Creek Road, a key access route to the local dump, shooting range and forest access as requiring significant improvement to ensure safety and accessibility for residents, businesses, and visitors; and

WHEREAS, the City of Seneca has been awarded the sum of **\$250,000** for the purpose of paving, repairing, and improving the portion of Shirttail Creek Road leading toward the dump, as part of the 2025 Special City Allotment Program; and

WHEREAS, this project will contribute to the long-term sustainability of the road infrastructure, enhance safety for all road users, and ensure continued and improved access to critical services; and

WHEREAS, the City of Seneca is committed to the effective and efficient use of the allocated funds for the betterment of the community and its infrastructure.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of Seneca, Oregon:


1. The City of Seneca hereby accepts and approves the allocation of \$250,000 in state highway funds administered by the Oregon Transportation Commission for the paving, repair, and improvement of Shirttail Creek Road toward the dump.
2. The City Council authorizes the Public Works Department to initiate the necessary steps to plan, design, and implement the improvements on Shirttail Creek Road, in accordance with all applicable local, state, and federal guidelines and regulations.
3. The City Council affirms its commitment to overseeing the proper and efficient expenditure of these funds, ensuring the timely and successful completion of this important infrastructure project.
4. The City of Seneca will continue to work closely with the Oregon Transportation Commission and other relevant state agencies to ensure the success of this project and to address any further needs for road improvements in the future.
