- Seneca Paving Project Bid Review and Intent to Award Discussion
 Mayor Officer announced the purpose of the meeting was to review bids received for the Seneca Paving Project. Three qualifying bids were received and opened publicly:
- Heckman Contracting: \$238,876
- JAL Construction: \$332,610
- High Desert Paving: \$427,000

All bidders submitted the required surety and documentation. Based on the lowest responsible bid, the intent is to award the project to **Heckman Contracting**.

2. Resolution 2025-03 – Adoption of the 2025–2026 Fiscal Year Budget
Mayor Officer presented Resolution No. 2025-03, adopting the 2025–2026 budget in the total amount of \$963,405 and appropriating funds as follows:

Mayor Officer also stated the city would impose property taxes at the rate of \$6.0017 per \$1,000 of assessed value for operations, as provided for in the adopted budget.
