

## RESOLUTION 03-17

### A RESOLUTION SETTING THE DUMPING RATES FOR ALL USERS OF THE SENECA CITY TRANSFER STATION

**WHEREAS**, the City Council for the City of Seneca has determined that The City of Seneca has an obligation to operate the city transfer station in an efficient and financially responsible manner;

**WHEREAS**, the City Council for the City of Seneca, has determined that it is in the City of Seneca's public health, safety and welfare that each Voluntary Transfer User shall have access to this service and shall be assessed the following fee schedule for household trash and an additional fee for non household trash ;

***Household Trash:***
