

RESOLUTION NO. 1

A RESOLUTION AFFIRMING THE CITY OF SENECA COMPLIANCE WITH  
TITLE VIII OF THE CIVIL RIGHTS ACT OF 1968 AS AMENDED, AND EXECUTIVE  
ORDER 11063 PROVIDING FOR FAIR HOUSING.

WHEREAS, Federal laws and regulations have been passed and  
are in effect to provide fair, non-discriminatory housing throughout the  
United States; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Seneca concurs with the stated federal  
policies of promoting maximum choice within the community's housing supply,  
lessening racial, ethnic and economic concentrations; and facilitating  
desegregation and racially inclusive patterns of occupancy and use of public  
facilities; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Housing and Urban Development and the  
Community Development Grant Program requires the city's assurance of compliance  
with said laws and regulations,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

That the City of Seneca concurs with Title VIII of  
the Civil Rights Act of 1968 as amended (commonly referred to as the "Fair  
Housing Law") and Executive Order 11063, and will administer all programs  
of the city related to Housing and Urban Development in a manner to affirmatively  
further fair housing.
