4. Open Floor

Grant County Library – Funding & Feasibility Study (Presenter: Stephanie Thompson) Ms. Thompson briefed Council on Grant County's budget shortfall and the County Court's process under ORS 357.621 to hold two public hearings on the library's status. She reported that funds were allocated to keep the library open through June 2026; without a new funding source, the library will close thereafter. The first hearing (July 22) drew 200+ attendees in support; the second hearing is October 21, 2025. The Save Our Library Committee is conducting a feasibility study comparing a five-year operating levy versus a special library district, with findings due by January 2026.
